The 67th Canadian Police Curling Championship is a week-long event that will be held April 6-13, 2024 in Whitby Ontario. This will be the ninth time since the Championship began in 1956 that the event will be hosted in Ontario. The competition mirrors the Tim Horton's Brier and Scotties Tournament of Hearts in that police officers from across the country compete in their provincial championships to qualify for one of twelve spots to represent their province in the national championships.

Recent changes to the Championships allow for peace officers to participate, which include Wildlife, Border Services, Federal Fisheries, and Corrections Canada in addition to police officers. The Canadian Police Curling Championship has been held in consecutive years since 1956 (with the exception of the pandemic years) and is the 3rd oldest national curling championship in Canada!

As the Canadian Police Curling Association (CPCA) is non-profit, we have to raise funds through sponsorship to fund the event.
